Races

- Race date: Friday 29th March 2024. Estimated start window 11am-3pm.
- Elite sprint races for M/W21E. Other class runners (for example, but not limited to, 18E and 20E) may enter this race and be counted in the WRE results. They will be divided for the purposes of the JK results into their own classes.
- Expected winning time 12-15 minutes
- All championship class competitors must be either a member of British Orienteering or a member of an IOF affiliated Federation.
- Anyone entering the World Ranking courses must provide their IOF ID if they would like to receive World Ranking points. Anyone entering these classes without an IOF ID will not receive World Ranking points. IOF World Ranking IDs can be found here.
- Embargoed area: JK embargo
 - Loughborough University has three hotels. The Link Hotel and Burleigh Court are outside the embargoed area and can be used providing athletes do not enter the

embargoed area. The *Elite Athlete Hotel* cannot be used by competitive athletes before the event.

- SI punching will be used with SIAC enabled.
 - The start will be a timed start with changes to start times not permitted
 - For those using contactless punching the finish will be contactless
- A model area and map will be provided on the day
- No training opportunities will be provided on the terrain

- A4 map, to ISSprOM 2019-2, scale 1:4000, contour interval 2m,digitally printed by Hassall & Lucking on waterproof paper.
- The terrain is typical university campus sitting on the North side of a big east west ridge. There are many steps, slopes, paths, paved and grassed areas.

- Shoes with some form of grip for off road running are recommended
- Shoes with metal spikes or dobs are not permitted.
