

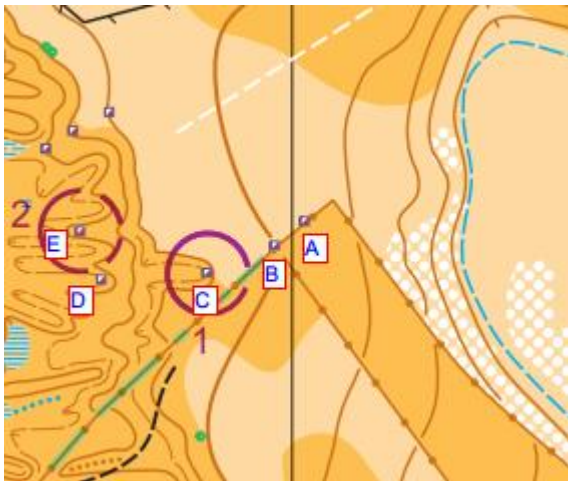
JK 2022 TrailO – Post event comments

Many thanks to all who participated in the TrailO competitions at the JK this year, and especially those who also found time to help run the events. I hope you enjoyed the new short format at Singleton Park, and felt that this fitted well with the FootO sprint format.

At Brynmawr the weather was the best I have seen there. There are a couple of explanatory notes on the results both in the Standard and the Elite course.

On the Standard course control 10 was voided because a fallen flag made the solution ambiguous, because the cluster effectively moved to the right one flag. This change was included in the results.

It has also been spotted by some of you that the Standard results and solutions for control 2 are incorrect. The cluster is A-E, and the correct answer is clearly E and not A. I have lettered the flags in this extract:



While the Standard results have not been re-issued, you can easily see the impact of this correction.

On the Elite course 2 controls were voided after the event. Control 2 was too high on the correct spur, and above the form line, while the centre of the circle was below the form line. Control 16 on the other hand was on the form line below the centre of the circle. In both cases these were sufficiently incorrectly placed to make the possibility of a Zero answer reasonable even allowing for a 4m zero tolerance, and so made the controls unfair. This voiding was included in the results on the day.

I hope that you all enjoyed the experience and the courses.
